



MONTANUNIVERSITÄT LEOBEN STUDENT REPRESENTS EURECA-PRO AT THE 1st CONFERENCE FOR STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES IN EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY ALLIANCES

The 1st Conference for Student Representatives in European University Alliances organised by <u>ESU</u> (European Student's Union) and <u>FAIRe (Academic Forum for Information and External</u> <u>Representation</u>) took place from 7th of December to 10th of December 2023 in Coimbra, Portugal.

The conference had approximately 80 participants, including student representatives from 38 out of 50 alliances, general coordinators, representatives of the European Commission, the European Students Union (ESU) and the Erasmus+ Portugal Agency. Organised closely with the Municipality of Coimbra, the University of Coimbra, the Academic Association of Coimbra and the Erasmus+ Portugal Agency, the conference was held to discuss and shape the future of higher education collaboration across borders.

Olivia Yakunina, student representative and member of the Student Co-Creation group, represented the European University on Responsible Consumption and Production (EURECA-PRO) during the event. Central topics focusing on the development of the European Alliances such as student representation, continuity, student mobility, quality assurance and joint degrees were discussed. The event allowed student representatives from all participating alliances to share their experiences, best practices and struggles through workshops and discussions with regard to defending students' rights. Additionally, the importance of preserving cultural heritage was highlighted and the students got the chance to experience Coimbra's culture during their stay.
