OBJECTIVES

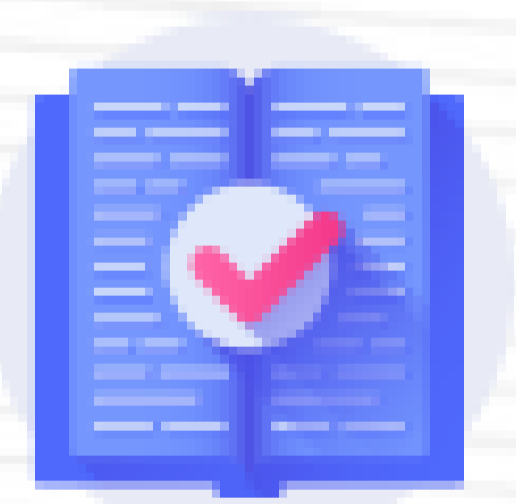
- to analyse the current state, possibilities and limitations of the **use of existing structures** related to research of each alliance member institution,

maps of governance models and structures related to research administration at each University



description of financial regulations related to purchasing, using, maintenance and depreciation of research infrastructure

description of regulatory and legal aspects concerning conducting research, with the emphasis of issues limiting common usage of the research infrastructure



description of university research centres and key laboratories

description of national funding sources for research, including grant agencies, university funding sources and funding sources for cooperation with industry



description of good practices related to conducting research

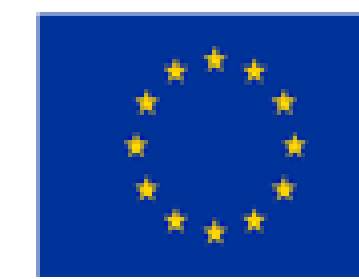
